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#### Helsinki Principle 6:

Engagement of Finance Ministries on NDC Planning and Implementation


#### Key elements include:

- taking a leading role in the formulation and update of NDCs or supporting government entities responsible for NDCs;
- working with other ministries and financial institutions to ensure that policies are coordinated, coherent and aligned with the achievement of the NDCs;
- providing technical input relevant to NDC formulation, such as macroeconomic forecasting, least-cost pathways for emissions reduction, and costing guidelines for specific measures;
- supporting the integration of NDC requirements into climate-informed appraisal and analysis of policies and programs sponsored by other ministries; and
- coordinating technical assistance and financing provided by international institutions for NDC preparation and the integration of NDCs in government's policies, programs and procedures.




# Key Challenges for NDC Planning and Implementation


- National Ownership: Climate policies, including the Nationally Determined Contribution (NDC), traditionally overseen by environment ministries often have limited power and are now getting higher priority. Ministry of Finance can drive a whole of government approach towards low-carbon and climate-resilient development.
- Inter-Ministerial Coordination: To ensure successful implementation of the NDCs, coordinated efforts are needed to ensure that those commitments are properly mainstreamed into national development plans as well as sectoral plans, and that they are fully costed and captured in the national budgetary processes.
- Access to Climate Finance: Mobilizing climate finance (e.g. domestic budget, private sector, and international public finance) for NDC implementation will require significant policy and regulatory reforms which involve various national stakeholders, including ministries in charge of finance and budget, development planning.




Does the MoF support the integration of NDC requirements into climateinformed appraisal and analysis of policies and programs sponsored by other ministries?




